PART 1 ~ TENDERING PROCEDURES

SECTION I:INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

A. General Provisions

1 Scope of Tender

1.1. The Procuring Entity as defined in the TDS invites tenders for supply of goods and, if applicable, any Related Services incidental thereto, as specified in Section V, Supply Requirements. The name, identification, and number of lots (contracts) of this Tender Document are specified in the TDS.

1.2. Throughout this tendering document:

- a) the term "in writing" means communicated in written form (e.g.,by mail, e-mail, fax, including if specified in the TDS, distributed or received through the electronic-procurement system used by the Procuring Entity) with proof of receipt;
- b) if the context so requires, "singular" means "plural" and vice versa;
- c) "Day" means calendar day, unless otherwise specified as "Business Day". A Business Day is any day that is an official working day of the Procuring Entity. It excludes official public holidays and weekends.

2 Fraud and Corruption

- 2.1. The Procuring Entityrequirescompliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015, Section 62 "Declaration not to engage incorruption". The tender submitted by a person shall include a declaration that the person shall not engage in any corrupt or fraudulent practice and a declaration that the person or his or her sub-contractors are not debarred from participating in public procurement proceedings
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity requires compliance with the provisions of the Competition Act 2010, regarding collusive practices in contracting. Any tenderer found to have engaged in collusive conduct shall be disqualified and criminal and/or civil sanctions may be imposed. To this effect, Tenders shall berequired to complete and signthe "Certificate of Independent Tender Determination" annexed to the Form of Tender.
- 2.3. Unfair Competitive Advantage ~ Fairness and transparency in the tender process requires that the firms or their Affiliates competing for a specific assignment do not derive a competitive advantage from having provided consulting services related to this tender. To that end, the Procuring Entity shall indicate in the Data Sheet and make available to all the firms together with this tender document all information that would in that respect give such firm any unfair competitive advantage over competing firms.

3 Eligible Tenderers

3.1. A Tenderer may be a firm that is a private entity, an individual, a state-owned enterprise or institution subject to ITT3.7, or any combination of such entities in the form of a joint venture (JV) under an existing agreement or with the intent to enter into such an agreement supported by a letter of intent. Public employees and their close relatives (spouses, children, brothers, sisters and uncles and aunts) are not eligible to participate in the tender.

In the case of a joint venture, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the entire Contractinac cordance with the Contract terms. The JV shall nominate a Representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the JV during the Tendering process and, in the event the JV is awarded the Contract, during contract execution. The maximum number of JV members shall be specified in the

TDS.

- 3.2. Public Officers of the Procuring Entity, their Spouses, Child, Parent, Brothers or Sister Child, Parent, Brother or Sister of a Spouse their business associates or agents and firms/organizations in which they have a substantial or controlling interest shall not be eligible to tender or be awarded a contract. Public Officers are also not allowed to participate in any procurement proceedings.
- 3.3. A Tenderer shall not have a conflict of interest. Any Tenderer found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Tenderer may be considered to have a conflict of interest for the purpose of this Tendering process, if the Tenderer:
 - a) directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by or is under common control with another Tenderer; or
 - b) receives or has received any direct or indirect subsidy from another Tenderer; or
 - c) has the same representative or ownership as another Tenderer; or
 - d) has a relationship with another Tenderer, directly or through common third parties, that puts it in a position to influence the Tender of another Tenderer, or influence the decisions of the Procuring Entity regarding this Tendering process; or
 - e) or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the goods that are the subject of the Tender; or
 - f) or any of its affiliates has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the Procuring Entity or Procuring Entity for the Contract implementation; or
 - g) wouldbeprovidinggoods,works,ornon-consultingservicesresultingfromordirectlyrelatedtoconsultingservicesforthepreparationori mplementationoftheprojectspecifiedinthe TDSITT1.1thatitprovidedorwere provided by any a ffiliate that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with that fir m; or has a close business or family relationship with a professional staff of the Procuring Entity (or of the project implementing agency, who: (i) are directly or indirectly involved in the preparation of the tendering documentors pecifications of the Contract, and/or the Tenderevaluation processof such Contract; or (ii) would be involved in the implementation or supervision of such Contract unless the conflict stemming from such relationship has been resolved in a manner acceptable to the Procuring Entity throughout the Tendering process and execution of the Contract.
- 3.4. A tenderer shall not be involved in corrupt, coercive, obstructive, collusive or fraudulent practice. A tenderer that is proventohavebeeninvolvedinanyofthesepractices shall be automatically disqualified.
- 3.5. A firm that is a Tenderer (either individually or as a JV member) shall not submit more than one Tender, except for permitted alternative Tenders. This includes participation as a subcontractor. Such participation shall result in the disqualification of all Tenders in which the firm is involved. A firm that is not a Tenderer or a JV member, may participate as a subcontractor in more than one Tender. Members of a joint venture may not also make an individual tender, be a subcontractor in a separate tender or be part of another joint venture for the purposes of the same Tender.
- 3.6. A Tenderer may have the nationality of any country, subject to the restrictions pursuant to ITT3.9.A Tenderer shall be deemed to have the nationality of a country if the Tenderer is constituted, incorporated or registered in and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of that country, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation (or equivalent documents of constitution or association) and its registration documents, as the case may be. This criterion also shall apply to the determination of the nationality of proposed subcontractors or sub consultants for any part of the Contract including related Services.
- 3.7. A Tenderer that has been debarred by the PPRA from participating in public procurement

shall be ineligible to tender or be awarded a contract. The list of debarred firms and individuals is available from the PPRA's websitewww.ppra.go.ke.

3.8. Tenderersthatarestate-

ownedenterprisesorinstitutionsmaybeeligibletocompeteandbeawardedaContract(s)onlyifthey are(i)AlegalpublicentityofthestateGovernmentand/orpublicadministration,(ii)Financiallyauto nomousandnotreceivinganysignificantsubsidiesorbudgetsupportfromanypublicentityorGover nment,and(iii)Operatingundercommerciallawandvestedwithlegalrightsandliabilitiessimilarto anycommercialenterprisetoenableitcompetewithfirmsintheprivatesectoronanequalbasis.Publi c employees and their close relatives are not eligible to participate in the tender.

- 3.9. Tenderersmaybeineligibleiftheircountriesoforigin(a) asamatteroflaworofficialregulations, Keny aprohibitscommercialrelations with that country, or (b) by an act of compliance with a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, Kenyaprohibits any import of goods or contracting for supplyof goods or services from that country, or any payments to any country, person, or entity in that country. A tenderer shall provide such documentary evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Procuring Entity, as the Procuring Entity shall reasonably request.
- 3.10. Tenderersshallprovidethequalificationinformationstatementthatthetenderer(includingallme mbersofajointventureandsubcontractors)isnotassociated,orhavebeenassociatedinthepast,dire ctlyorindirectly,withafirmoranyofitsaffiliateswhichhavebeenengagedbytheProcuringentitytop rovideconsultingservices forthepreparationofthedesign,specifications,andotherdocumentstobeusedfortheprocurement ofthegoodsunderthisInvitationfortenders.
- 3.11. Where the law requires tenderers to be registered with certain authorities in Kenya, such registration requirements shall be defined in the TDS
- 3.12. The Competition Act of Kenya requires that firms wishing to tender as Joint Venture undertakings which may prevent, distort or lessen competition in provision of services are prohibited unless they are exempt in accordance with the provisionsofSection25oftheCompetitionAct,2010.JVs will be required to seek for exemption from the Competition Authority.Exemption shall not be a condition for tender, but it shall be a condition of contract award and signature.A JV tenderer shall be given opportunity to seek such exemption as a condition of award and signature of contract.Application for exemption from the Competition Authority of Kenya may be accessed from the websitewww.cak.go.ke.
- 3.13. A Kenyan tenderer shall provide evidence of having fulfilled his/her tax obligations by producing a current tax clearance certificate or tax exemption certificate issued by the Kenya Revenue Authority.

4 Eligible Goods and Related Services

- 4.1 All the Goods and Related Services to be supplied under the Contract shall have their origin in any country that is eligible in accordance with ITT 3.9.
- 4.2 For purposes of this ITT, the term "goods" includes commodities, raw material, machinery, equipment, and industrial plants; and "related services" include services such as insurance, installation, training, and initial maintenance.
- 4.3 The term "origin" means the country where the goods have been mined, grown, cultivated, produced, manufactured or processed; or, through manufacture, processing, or assembly, another commercially recognized article results that differs substantially in its basic characteristics from its components.
- 4.4 A procuring entity shall ensure that the items listed below shall be sourced from Kenya and

there shall be no substitutions from foreign sources. The affected items are:

- a) Motor vehicles, plant and equipment which are assembled in Kenya;
- b) Furniture, textile, foodstuffs, oil and gas, information communication technology, steel, cement, leather, agro-processed products, sanitary products, and other goods made in Kenya; or
- c) Goods manufactured, mined, extracted or grown in Kenya.
- 4.5 Any goods, works and production processes with characteristics that have been declared by the relevant national environmental protection agency or by other competent authority as harmful to human beings and to the environment shall not be eligible for procurement.

- 5.2 The notice of Invitation to Tender or the notice to the prequalified Tenderers issued by the Procuring Entity is not part of the tendering document.
- 5.3 Unless obtained directly from the Procuring Entity, the Procuring Entity is not responsible for the completeness of the document, responses to requests for clarification, the minutes of the pre-tender meeting (if any), or addenda to the tendering document in accordance with ITT7.
- 5.4 The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the tendering document and to furnish with its Tender all information or documentation as is required by the tendering document.

6 Clarification of Tendering Document

6.1 A Tenderer requiring any clarification of the Tender Document shall contact the Procuring Entity in writing at the Procuring Entity's address specified in the TDS or raise its enquiries during the pre-Tender meeting if provided for in accordance with ITT 6.4. The Procuring Entity will respond in writing to any request for clarification, provided that such request is received no later than the period specified in the TDS prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. The Procuring Entity shall forward copies of its response to all tenderers who have acquired the Tender documents in accordance with ITT 5.3, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. If so specified in the TDS, the Procuring Entity shall also promptly publish its response at the web page identified in the TDS. Should the clarification result in changes to the essential elements of the Tender Documents, the Procuring Entity shall amend the Tender Documents following the procedure under ITT7.

- 6.2 The Procuring Entity shall specify in the TDS if a pre-tender conference will be held, when and where. The Tenderer's designated representative is invited to attend a pre-Tender meeting. The purpose of the meeting will be to clarify issues and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage.
- 6.3 The Tenderer is requested to submit any questions in writing, to reach the Procuring Entity not later than the period specified in the TDS before the meeting.
- 6.4 Minutes of the pre-Tender meeting, if applicable, including the text of the questions asked by Tenderers and the responses given, together with any responses prepared after the meeting, will be transmitted promptly to all Tenderers who haveacquiredtheTenderDocumentsinaccordancewithITT6.3.Minutes shall not identify the source of the questions asked.
- 6.5 The Procuring Entity shall also promptly publish anonymized (no names) Minutes of the pre-Tender meeting at the web page identified in the TDS.AnymodificationtotheTenderDocumentsthatmaybecomenecessaryasaresultofthepre-TendermeetingshallbemadebytheProcuringEntityexclusivelythroughtheissueofanAddendump ursuanttoITT7andnotthroughtheminutesofthepre-Tendermeeting.Nonattendance at the pre-Tender meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of a Tenderer.

7 Amendment of Tendering Document

- 7.1 AtanytimepriortothedeadlineforsubmissionofTenders,theProcuringEntitymayamendthetenderi ngdocumentbyissuingaddenda.
- 7.2 Any addendum issued shall be part of the tendering document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the tender document from the Procuring Entity in accordance with ITT 6.3. The Procuring Entity shall also promptly publish the addendum on the Procuring Entity's web page in accordance with ITT 7.1.
- 7.3 To give prospective Tenderers reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their Tenders, the Procuring Entity may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Tenders, pursuant to ITT 21.2.

C. Preparation of Tenders

8 Cost of Tendering

8.1 The Tenderershall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Tender, and the Procuring Entity shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conductor out come of the Tendering process.

9 Language of Tender

9.1 The Tender, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Tender exchanged by the Tenderer and the Procuring Entity, shall be written in English Language. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Tendermay beina nother language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages into the English Language, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Tender, such translation shall govern.

10 Documents Comprising the Tender

- 10.1 The Tender shall comprise the following:
 - a) Form of Tender prepared in accordance with ITT11;
 - b) Price Schedules:completed in accordance with ITT11 and ITT13;
 - c) Tender Security or Tender-Securing Declaration, in accordance with ITT 18.1;
 - d) Alternative Tender: if permissible, in accordance with ITT12;
 - e) Authorization:written confirmation authorizing the signatory of the Tender to commit the

- Tenderer, in accordance with ITT19.3;
- f) Qualifications:documentary evidence in accordance with ITT 16.2 establishing the Tenderer qualifications to perform the Contract if its Tender is accepted;
- g) Tenderer Eligibility:documentary evidence in accordance with ITT16.1 establishing the Tenderer eligibility to tender;
- h) Eligibility of Goods and Related Services:documentary evidence in accordance with ITT15, establishing the eligibility of the Goods and Related Services to be supplied by the Tenderer:
- i) Conformity:documentary evidence in accordance with ITT15.2 that the Goods and Related Services conform to the tender document; and
- j) Anyother document required in the TDS.
- 10.2 In addition to the requirements under ITT 10.1, Tenders submitted by a JV shall include a copy of the Joint Venture Agreement entered into by all members. Alternatively, a letter of intent to execute a Joint Venture Agreement in the event of a successful Tender shall be signed by all members and submitted with the Tender, together with a copy of the proposed Agreement.
- 10.3 The Tenderer shall furnish in the Form of Tender information on commissions gratuities, and fees, if any, paid or to be paid to agents or any other party relating to this Tender.

11 Form of Tender and Price Schedules

11.1 The Form of Tender and Price Schedules shall be prepared using the relevant forms furnished in Section IV, Tendering Forms. The forms must be completed without any alterations to the text. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested. The Tenderer shall chronologically serialize pages of all tender documents submitted.

12 Alternative Tenders

12.1 Unless otherwise specified in the TDS, alternative Tenders shall not be considered.

13 Tender Prices and discounts

- 13.1 The prices quoted by the Tenderer in the Form of Tender and in the Price, Schedules shallconform to the requirements specified below.
- 13.2 All lots (contracts) and items must be listed and priced separately in the Price Schedules.
- 13.3 The price to be quoted in the Form of Tender in accordance with ITT10.1 shall be the total price of the Tender, including any discounts offered.
- 13.4 The Tenderer shall quote any discounts and indicate the methodology for their application in the form of tender. Conditional discounts will be rejected.
- 13.5 Prices quoted by the Tenderer shall be fixed during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account, unless otherwise specified in the TDS.A Tender submitted with an adjustable price quotation shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be rejected, pursuant to ITT28.However, if in accordance with the TDS, prices quoted by the Tenderer shall be subject to adjustment during the performance of the Contract, a Tender submitted with a fixed price quotation shall not be rejected, but the price adjustment shall be treated as zero.
- 13.6 If specified in ITT 1.1, Tenders are being invited for individual lots (contracts) or for any combination of lots (packages). Unless otherwise specified in the TDS, prices quoted shall correspond to 100 % of the items specified for each lot and to 100% of the quantities specified for each item of a lot. Tenderers wishing to offer discounts for the award of more than one Contract shall specify in their Tender the price reductions applicable to

- eachpackage, or alternatively, to individual Contracts within the package. Discounts shall be submitted in accordance with ITT 13.4 provided the Tenders for all lots (contracts) are opened at the same time.
- 13.7 The terms EXW, CIP, CIF, DDP and other similar terms shall be governed by the rules prescribed in the current edition of Incoterms, published by the International Chamber of Commerce.
- 13.8 Prices shall be quoted as specified in each Price Schedule included in Section IV, Tendering Forms. The disaggregation of price components is required solely for the purpose of facilitating the comparison of Tenders by the Procuring Entity. This shall not in any way limit the Procuring Entity's right to contract on any of the terms offered. In quoting prices, the Tenderer shall be free to use transportation through carriers registered in any eligible country. Similarly, the Tenderer may obtain insurance services from any eligible country in accordance with ITT 3.6, Eligible Tenders. Prices shall be entered in the following manner:
 - a) For Goods manufactured in Kenya:
 - i. the price of the Goods quoted EXW (ex-works, ex-factory, ex warehouse, ex showroom, or off-the- shelf, as applicable) final destination point indicated in the TDS, including all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payableonthecomponents and rawmaterial used in the manufacture or assembly of the Goods;
 - ii. any sales tax and other taxes which will be payable in Kenya on the Goods if the Contractis awarded to the Tenderer; and
 - iii. The price for inland transportation, insurance, and other local services required to convey the Goods to their final destination specified in the TDS.
 - b) For Goods manufactured outside Kenya, to be imported:
 - i. the price of the Goods, quoted CIP named place of destination, in Kenya, as specified in the TDS;
 - ii. the price for inland transportation, insurance, and other local services required to convey the Goods from the named place of destination to their final destination specified in the TDS;
 - c) For Goods manufactured outside Kenya, already imported:
 - i. the price of the Goods, including the original import value of the Goods; plus, any mark-up (or rebate); plus, any other related local cost, and custom duties and other import taxes already paid or to be paid on the Goods already imported;
 - ii. the custom duties and other import taxes already paid (need to be supported with documentary evidence) or to be paid on the Goods already imported;
 - iii. Any sales and other taxes levied in Kenya which will be payable on the Goods if the Contract is awarded to the Tenderer; and
 - iv. The price for inland transportation, insurance, and other local services required to convey the Goods from the named place of destination to their final destination (Project Site) specified in the TDS.
 - d) For Related Services, other than inland transportation and other services required to convey the Goods to their final destination, whenever such Related Services are specified in the Schedule of Requirements, the price of each item comprising the Related Services (inclusive of any applicable taxes).

14 Currencies of Tender and Payment

14.1 The currency (ies) of the Tender, the currency (ies) of award and the currency (ies) of contract payments shall be the same.

- 14.2 The Tenderer shall quote in Kenya shillings. If allowed in the TDS, the Tenderer may express the Tender price in any currency, provided it shall use no more than two foreign currencies in addition to the Kenya Shilling.
- 14.3 The rates of exchange to be used by the Tenderer shall be based on the exchange rates provided by the Central Bank of Kenya on the date 30 days prior to the actual date of tender opening.

15 Documents Establishing the Eligibility and Conformity of the Goods and Related Services

- 15.1 To establish the eligibility of the Goods and Related Services in accordance with ITT15, Tenderers shall complete the country of origin declarations in the Price Schedule Forms, included in Section IV, Tendering Forms.
- 15.2 To establish the conformity of the Goods and Related Services to the tendering document, the Tenderer shall furnish as part of its Tender the documentary evidence that the Goods conform to the technical specifications and standards specified in Section VII, Schedule of Requirements.
- 15.3 Thedocumentaryevidencemaybeintheformofliterature, drawingsordata, and shall consist of a detailed item by item description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the Goods and Related Services, demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the Goods and Related Services to the technical specification, and if applicable, a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provision softhe Section VII, Schedule of Requirements.
- 15.4 The Tenderer shall also furnish a list giving full particulars, including available sources and current prices of spare parts, special tools, etc., necessary for the proper and continuing functioning of the Goods during the period specified in the TDS following commencement of the use of the goods by the Procuring Entity.
- 15.5 Standards for workmanship, process, material, and equipment, as well as references to brand names or catalogue numbers specified by the Procuring Entity in the Schedule of Requirements, are intended to be descriptive only and not restrictive. The Tenderer may offer other standards of quality, brand names, and/or catalogue numbers, provided that it demonstrates, to the Procuring Entity's satisfaction, that the substitutions ensure substantial equivalence or are superior to those specified in the Section VII, Schedule of Requirements.

16 Documents Establishing the Eligibility and Qualifications of the Tenderer

- 16.1 To establish Tenderer eligibility in accordance with ITT4, Tenderers shall complete the Form of Tender, included in Section IV, Tendering Forms.
- 16.2 The documentary evidence of the Tenderer qualifications to perform the Contract if its Tender is accepted shall establish to the Procuring Entity's satisfaction:
 - a) That, if required in the TDS, a Tenderer that does not manufacture or produce the Goods it offers to supply shall submit the Manufacturer's Authorization using the form included in Section IV, Tendering Forms to demonstrate that it has been duly authorized by the manufacturer or producer of the Goods to supply these Goods in Kenya;
 - b) That, if required in the TDS, in case of a Tenderer not doing business within the Kenya, the Tenderer is or will be (if awarded the Contract) represented by an Agent in the country equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair and spare parts-stocking obligations prescribed in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications; and
 - c) That the Tenderer meets each of the qualification criterion specified in Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.

17 Period of Validity of Tenders

- 17.1 Tenders shall remain valid for the Tender Validity period specified in the TDS. The Tender Validity period starts from the date fixed for the Tender submission deadline (as prescribed by the Procuring Entity in accordance with ITT 21.1). A Tender valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.
- 17.2 Inexceptionalcircumstances, priortothe expiration of the Tender validity period, the Procuring Entity may request Tenderer stoextend the period of validity of their Tenders. The request and the responses shall be made in writing. If a Tender Security is requested in accordance with ITT18, it shall also be extended for a corresponding period. A Tenderer may refuse the request without forfeiting its Tender Security. A Tenderer granting the request shall not be required or permitted to modify its Tender, except as provided in ITT 17.3.
- 17.3 If the award is delayed by a period exceeding the number of days to be specified in the TDS days beyond the expiry of the initial tender validity period, the Contract price shall be determined as follows:
 - a) In the case of fixed price contracts, the Contract price shall be the tender price adjusted by the factor specified in the TDS;
 - b) In the case of adjustable price contracts, no adjustment shall be made; or in any case, tender evaluation shall bebasedonthetenderpricewithouttakingintoconsiderationtheapplicablecorrectionfromtho seindicatedabove.

18 Tender Security

- 18.1 The Tenderer shall furnish as part of its Tender, either a Tender-Securing Declaration or a Tender Security, as specified in the TDS, in original form and, in the case of a Tender Security, in the amount and currency specified in the TDS.
- 18.2 A Tender Securing Declaration shall use the form included in Section IV, Tendering Forms.
- 18.3 If a Tender Security is specified pursuant to ITT 18.1, the Tender Security shall be a demand guarantee in any of the following forms at the Tenderer option:
 - i. Cash;
 - ii. A bank guarantee;
 - iii. A guarantee by an insurance company registered and licensed by the Insurance Regulatory Authority listed by the Authority; or
 - iv. A letter of credit; or
 - v. Guarantee by a deposit taking micro-finance institution, Sacco society, the Youth Enterprise Development Fund or the Women Enterprise Fund.
- If an unconditional guarantee is issued by a non-Bank financial institution located outside Kenya, the issuing non-Bank financial institution shall have a correspondent financial institution located in Kenya to make it enforceable unless the Procuring Entity has agreed in writing, prior to tender submission, that a correspondent financial institution is not required. In the case of a bank guarantee, the Tender Security shall be submitted either using the Tender Security Form included in Section IV, Tendering Forms, or in another substantially similar format approved by the Procuring Entity prior to Tender submission. The Tender Security shall be valid for thirty (30) days beyond the original validity period of the Tender, or beyond any period of extension if requested under ITT 17.2.
- 18.5 If a Tender Security is specified pursuant to ITT 18.1, any Tender not accompanied by a substantially responsive Tender Security shall be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

- 18.6 IfaTenderSecurityisspecifiedpursuanttoITT18.1,theTenderSecurityofunsuccessfulTendererss hallbereturnedaspromptlyaspossibleuponthesuccessfultenderersigningtheContractandfurni shingthePerformanceSecuritypursuanttoITT46.TheProcuringEntityshallalsopromptlyreturnt hetendersecuritytothetendererswheretheprocurementproceedingsareterminated,alltenders weredeterminednon-responsiveorabidderdeclinestoextendtendervalidityperiod.
- 18.7 The Tender Security of the successful Tenderer shall be returned as promptly as possible once the successful Tenderer has signed the Contract and furnished the required Performance Security.
- 18.8 The Tender Security may be forfeited or the Tender Securing Declaration executed:
 - a) if a Tenderer withdraws its Tender during the period of Tender validity specified by the Tenderer in the Form of Tender, or any extension thereto provided by the Tenderer; or
 - b) if the successful Tenderer fails to:
 - i. sign the Contract in accordance with ITT45; or
 - ii. Furnisha Performance Security in accordance with ITT 46.
- 18.9 Where tender securing declaration is executed, the Procuring Entity shall recommend to the PPRA that PPRA debars the Tenderer from participating in public procurement as provided in the law.
- 18.10 The Tender Security or Tender- Securing Declaration of a JV must be in the name of the JV that submits the Tender.If the JV has not been legally constituted into a legally enforceable JV at the time of Tendering, the Tender Security or Tender-Securing Declaration shall be in the names of all future members as named in the letter of intent referred to in ITT3.1 and ITT 10.2.
- 18.11 A tenderer shall not issue a tender security to guarantee itself.

19 Format and Signing of Tender

- 19.1 The Tenderer shall prepare one original of the documents comprising the Tender as described in ITT11 and clearly mark it "ORIGINAL." In addition, the Tenderer shall submit copies of the Tender, in the number specified in the TDS and clearly mark them "COPY." In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.
- 19.2 Tenderers shall mark as "CONFIDENTIAL" information in their Tenders which is confidential to their business. This may include proprietary information, trade secrets, or commercial or financially sensitive information.
- 19.3 The original and all copies of the Tender shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer. This authorization shall consist of a written confirmation as specified in the TDS and shall be attached to the Tender. The name and position held by each person signing the authorization must be typed or printed below the signature. All pages of the Tender where entries or amendments have been made shall be signed or initialed by the person signing the Tender.
- 19.4 In case the Tenderer is a JV, the Tender shall be signed by anauthorized representative of the JV on behalf of the JV, and so as to be legally binding on all the members as evidenced by a power of attorney signed by each member's legally authorized representatives.
- 19.5 Any inter-lineation, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the Tend er.

D. Submission and Opening of Tenders

20 Sealing and Marking of Tenders

- 20.1 Dependingonthesizesorquantitiesorweightofthetenderdocuments,atenderermayuseanenvelop e,packageorcontainer.The
 - Tenderershalldeliverthe Tenderinasinglesealedenvelope, orinasinglesealedpackage, orinasingle sealed container bearing the name and Reference number of the Tender, addressed to the Procuring Entity and awarning not to open before the time and date for Tenderopening date. Within the single envelope, package or container, the Tenderershall place the following separate, sealed envelopes:
 - a) Inanenvelopeorpackageorcontainermarked "ORIGINAL", alldocuments comprising the Tender, as described in ITT11; and in an envelopeorpackageorcontainermarked "COPIES", all required copies of the Tender.
- 20.2 Theinnerenvelopesorpackagesorcontainersshall:
 - a) Bear thenameandaddressoftheProcuringEntity.
 - b) BearthenameandaddressoftheTenderer;and
 - c) Bear thenameandReferencenumberoftheTender.
- 20.3 Whereatenderpackageorcontainercannotfitinthetenderbox, the procuring entity shall:
 - a) Specify in the TDS where such documents should be received.
 - b) Maintainarecordoftendersreceivedandissueacknowledgementreceiptnotetoeachtenderers pecifyingtimeanddateofreceipt.
 - c) Ensurealltendersreceivedarehandedovertothetenderopeningcommitteeforopeningatthesp ecifiedopeningplaceandtime.
- 20.4 Ifanenvelopeorpackageorcontainerisnotsealedandmarkedasrequired,theProcuringEntitywilla ssumenoresponsibilityforthemisplacementorprematureopeningoftheTender.Tenders misplaced or opened prematurely will not be accepted.

21 Deadline for Submission of Tenders

- 21.1 TendersmustbereceivedbytheProcuringEntityattheaddressandnolaterthanthedateandtimespec ifiedintheTDS.WhensospecifiedintheTDS,TenderersshallhavetheoptionofsubmittingtheirTend erselectronically.TendererssubmittingTenderselectronicallyshallfollowtheelectronicTendersu bmissionproceduresspecifiedintheTDS.
- 21.2 The Procuring Entitymay, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Tenders by amen ding the tendering document in accordance with ITT7, in which case all rights and obligations of the Procuring Entity and Tenderers previously subject to the dead line as extended.

22 Late Tenders

22.1 TheProcuringEntityshallnotconsideranyTenderthatarrivesafterthedeadlineforsubmissionofTe nders.AnyTenderreceivedbytheProcuringEntityafterthedeadlineforsubmissionofTendersshallb edeclaredlate,rejected,andreturnedunopenedtotheTenderer.

23 Withdrawal, Substitution, and Modification of Tenders

- 23.1 ATenderermaywithdraw, substitute, ormodify its Tenderafter it has been submitted by sending a written notice, duly signed by an authorized representative, and shall include a copy of the authorization (the power of attorney) in accordance with ITT 19.3, (except that with draw alnotices do not require opies). The corresponding substitution or modification of the Tendermust accompany the respective written notice. All notices must be:
 - a) Prepared and submitted in accordance with ITT20 and 21 (except that with draw alnotices do not require copies), and in addition, there spective envelopes shall be clearly marked "WITHDRAW AL," "SUBSTITUTION," or "MODIFICATION;" and
 - b) Received by the Procuring Entity prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of Tenders, in acc

ordancewithITT22.

- 23.2 Tendersrequested to be with drawn in accordance with ITT 23.1 shall be returned unopened to the Tenderers.
- 23.3 NoTendermaybewithdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of Tenders and the expiration of the period of Tender validity specified by the Tender eron the Form of Tender or any extension thereof.

24 Tender Opening

- 24.1 ExceptasinthecasesspecifiedinITT23,theProcuringEntityshall,attheTenderopening,publiclyope nandreadoutallTendersreceivedbythedeadlineatthedate,timeandplacespecifiedintheTDSinthe presenceofTenderers'designatedrepresentativeswhochoosetoattend,includingtoattendanyspec ificelectronictenderopeningproceduresifelectronictenderingispermittedinaccordancewithITT 21.1,shallbeasspecifiedintheTDS.
- 24.2 First,envelopesmarked "WITHDRAWAL" shall be opened and readout and the envelope with the corresponding Tendershall not be opened, but returned to the Tenderer. If the withdraw alenvelopedoes not contain a copy of the "power of attorney" confirming the signature as a personduly authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer, the corresponding Tender will be opened. No Tender with draw als hall be epermitted unless the corresponding with draw alnotice contains a validauthorization to request the withdraw aland is readout at Tender opening.
- 24.3 Next,envelopesmarked "SUBSTITUTION" shall be opened and readout and exchanged with the corresponding Tender being substituted, and the substituted Tender shall not be opened, but returned to the Tenderer. No Tender substitution shall be permitted unless the corresponding substitution notice contains a validauthorization to request the substitution and is readout at Tender opening.
- 24.4 Next, envelopes marked "MODIFICATION" shall be opened and readout with the corresponding Tender. No Tender modification shall be permitted unless the corresponding modification notice contains a validauthorization to request the modification and is readout at Tender opening.
- 24.5 Next, all remaining envelopes shall be opened on eatatime, reading out: the name of the Tenderer and whether the reisamo diffication; the total Tender Prices, per lot (contract) if applicable, including any discounts and alternative Tenders; the presence or absence of a Tender Security, if required; and any of the redetails as the Procuring Entity may consider appropriate.
- 24.6 OnlyTenders,alternativeTendersanddiscountsthatareopenedandreadoutatTenderopeningshall beconsideredfurtherforevaluation.TheFormofTenderandpagesoftheBillsofQuantitiesaretobein itialedbythemembersofthetenderopeningcommitteeattendingtheopening.Thenumberofrepres entativesoftheProcuringEntitytosignshallbespecifiedintheTDS.
- 24.7 The Procuring Entity shall neither discuss the merits of any Tender nor reject any Tender (except for late eTenders, in accordance with ITT 22.1).
- 24.8 The Procuring Entity shall prepare are cord of the Tenderopening that shall include, as a minimum:
 - a) thenameoftheTendererandwhetherthereisawithdrawal,substitution,ormodification;
 - b) the Tender Price, perlot (contract) if applicable, including any discounts;
 - c) anyalternativeTenders;
 - d) the presence or absence of a Tender Security or Tender Securing Declaration, if one was required;
 - e) Number ofpagesofeachtenderdocumentsubmitted.
- 24.9 TheTenderers'representativeswhoarepresentshallberequestedtosigntherecord. Theomissionofa Tenderersignatureontherecordshallnotinvalidatethecontentsandeffectoftherecord. Acopyofthe tenderopening registershall be issued to a Tenderer upon request.

E. Evaluation and Comparison of Tenders

- 25.1 InformationrelatingtotheevaluationofTendersandrecommendationofcontractaward,shallnotb edisclosedtoTenderersoranyotherpersonsnotofficiallyconcernedwiththetenderingprocessuntil theinformationonIntentiontoAwardtheContractistransmittedtoallTenderersinaccordancewith ITT41.
- 25.2 AnyeffortbyaTenderertoinfluencetheProcuringEntityintheevaluationorcontractawarddecision smayresultintherejectionofitsTender.
- 25.3 NotwithstandingITT25.2,fromthetimeofTenderopeningtothetimeofContractAward,ifanyTend ererwishestocontacttheProcuringEntityonanymatterrelatedtotheTenderingprocess,itshoulddo soinwriting.

26 Clarification of Tenders

- 26.1 Toassistintheexamination, evaluation, comparison of the Tenders, and qualification of the Tenderer s, the Procuring Entity may, at its discretion, askany Tenderer for a clarification of its Tender. Any clarification submitted by a Tenderer in respect to its Tender and that is not in response to a request by the Procuring Entity shall not be considered. The Procuring Entity's request for clarification and the response shall be inwriting. No change, including any voluntary increase or decrease, in the prices or substance of the Tendershall be sought, offered, or permitted except to confirm the correction of a rithmetic errors discovered by the Procuring Entity in the Evaluation of the Tenders, in accordance with ITT 30.
- 26.2 IfaTendererdoesnotprovideclarificationsofitsTenderbythedateandtimesetintheProcuringEntity 'srequestforclarification,itsTendermayberejected.

27 Deviations, Reservations, and Omissions

- 27.1 Duringtheevaluation of Tenders, the following definition sapply:
 - a) "Deviation" isadeparture from the requirements specified in the Tendering document:
 - b) "Reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from complete acceptance of the erequirements specified in the tendering document; and
 - c) "Omission" isthefailure to submit partoral lofthein formation or documentation required in the tendering document.

28 Determination of Responsiveness

- 28.1 The Procuring Entity's determination of a Tender's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Tender itself, as defined in ITT 28.2.
- 28.2 AsubstantiallyresponsiveTenderisonethatmeetstherequirementsofthetenderingdocumentwith outmaterialdeviation,reservation,oromission.Amaterialdeviation,reservation,oromissionisone that:
 - a) ifaccepted, would:
 - i) affectinanysubstantialwaythescope, quality, or performance of the Goods and Related Servic esspecified in the Contract; or
 - ii) limitinanysubstantialway,inconsistentwiththetenderingdocument,the Procuring Entity's rightsorthe Tendererobligation sunder the Contract; or
 - b) ifrectified, would unfairly affect the competitive position of other Tenderers presenting substant ially responsive Tenders.
- 28.3 The Procuring Entity shall examine the technical aspects of the Tendersubmitted in accordance with IT15 and ITT16, in particular, to confirm that all requirements of Section VII, Schedule of Requirements of Section VIII, Schedule of Section VIII, Se

- ntshavebeenmetwithoutanymaterialdeviationorreservation, oromission.
- 28.4 IfaTenderisnotsubstantiallyresponsivetotherequirementsoftenderingdocument,itshallbereject edbytheProcuringEntityandmaynotsubsequentlybemaderesponsivebycorrectionofthematerial deviation,reservation,oromission.

29 Non-conformities, Errors and Omissions

- 29.1 Provided that a Tender is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity may waive any non-conformities in the Tender.
- 29.2 ProvidedthataTenderissubstantiallyresponsive,theProcuringEntitymayrequestthattheTenderer submitthenecessaryinformationordocumentation,withinareasonableperiodoftime,torectifyno nmaterialnon-conformitiesoromissionsintheTenderrelatedtodocumentationrequirements.Suchomissionshall notberelatedtoanyaspectofthePriceoftheTender.FailureoftheTenderertocomplywiththerequest mayresultintherejectionofitsTender.
- 29.3 ProvidedthataTenderissubstantiallyresponsive,theProcuringEntityshallrectifyquantifiablenon materialnon-conformitiesrelatedtotheTenderPrice.Tothiseffect,theTenderPriceshallbeadjusted,forcomparis onpurposesonly,toreflectthepriceofamissingornon-conformingitemorcomponentinthemannerspecifiedintheTDS.Theadjustmentshallbebasedont heaveragepriceoftheitemorcomponentasquotedinothersubstantiallyresponsiveTenders.IfthepriceoftheitemorcomponentcannotbederivedfromthepriceofothersubstantiallyresponsiveTenders,theProcuringEntityshalluseitsbestestimate.

30 Arithmetical Errors

- 30.1 Thetendersumassubmittedandreadoutduringthetenderopeningshallbeabsoluteandfinalandsh allnotbethesubjectofcorrection,adjustmentoramendmentinanywaybyanypersonorentity.
- 30.2 Provided that the Tenderis substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity shall handle errors on the following basis:
 - a) Anyerrordetectedifconsideredamajordeviationthataffectsthesubstanceofthetender, shalllea dtodisqualification of the tender as non-responsive.
 - b) Anyerrorsinthesubmittedtenderarisingfromamiscalculationofunitprice, quantity, subtotala ndtotalbidpriceshallbeconsideredasamajordeviation that affects the substance of the tenderan dshall lead to disqualification of the tenderas non-responsive. and
 - c) Ifthereisadiscrepancybetweenwordsandfigures, the amount inwords shall prevail.
- 30.3 Tenderersshallbenotifiedofanyerrordetectedintheirbidduringthenotificationofaward.

31 Conversion to Single Currency

31.1 Forevaluationandcomparisonpurposes, the currency (ies) of the Tendershall be converted in a single ecurrency as specified in the TDS.

32 Margin of Preference and Reservations

- 32.1 Amarginofpreferencemaybeallowedonlocallymanufacturedgoodsonlywhenthecontractisopen tointernationaltendering, wherethetenderislikelytoattractforeigngoodsandwherethecontracte xceedsthethresholdspecifiedintheRegulations.
- 32.2 Forpurposesofgrantingamarginofpreferenceonlocallymanufacturedgoodsunderinternational competitivetendering, aprocuringentity shall not subject the items listed below to international tend erandhence no marginof preference shall be allowed. The affected items are:
 - a) Motorvehicles, plantandequipment which are assembled in Kenya;
 - b) Furniture, textile, foodstuffs, oil and gas, information communication technology, steel, cement

- ,leatheragro-processing,sanitaryproducts,andothergoodsmadeinKenya;or
- c) Goods manufactured, mined, extracted or grown in Kenya.
- 32.3 AmarginofpreferenceshallnotbeallowedunlessitisspecifiedsointheTDS
- 32.4 Contractsprocuredonbasisofinternationalcompetitivetenderingshallnotbesubjecttoreservation stospecificgroupssasprovidedinITT32.5.
- 32.5 Whereitisintendedtoreserveacontracttoaspecificgroupofbusinesses (thesegroupsareSmalland MediumEnterprises, WomenEnterprises, YouthEnterprises andEnterprises ofpersonsliving with disability, as the case may be), and who are appropriately registered as such by the authority to be specified in the TDS, approcuring entity shall ensure that the invitation to tender specifically indicates that only businesses or firms belonging to the specified group are eligible to tender as specified in the TDS. No tender shall be reserved to more than one group. If not so stated in the Tenderdocuments, the invitation to tender will be open to all interested tenderers.

33 Evaluation of Tenders

- 33.1 TheProcuringEntityshallusethecriteriaandmethodologieslistedinthisITTandSectionIII,Evaluati onandQualificationcriteria.No other evaluation criteria or methodologies shall be permitted.Byapplyingthecriteriaandmethodologies,theProcuringEntityshalldeterminetheLowe stEvaluatedTender.ThisistheTenderoftheTendererthatmeetsthequalificationcriteriaandwhoseT enderhasbeendeterminedtobe:
 - a) Substantially responsive to the tender documents; and
 - b) The lowestevaluated price.
- 33.2 PriceevaluationwillbedoneforItemsorLots(contracts),asspecifiedintheTDS;andtheTenderPrice asquotedinaccordancewithITT14.ToevaluateaTender,theProcuringEntityshallconsiderthefollowing:
 - a) priceadjustmentduetounconditionaldiscountsofferedinaccordancewithITT13.4;
 - b) converting the amount resulting from applying (a) and (b) above, if relevant, to a single currency in accordance with ITT31;
 - c) priceadjustmentduetoquantifiablenonmaterialnon-conformitiesinaccordancewithITT29.3;and
 - d) AnyadditionalevaluationfactorsspecifiedintheTDSandSectionIII,EvaluationandQualificationCriteria.
- 33.3 Theestimated effect of the price adjustment provisions of the Conditions of Contract, applied over the period of execution of the Contract, shall not be considered in Tender evaluation.
- 33.4 Wherethetenderinvolvesmultiplelotsorcontracts, the tenderer will be allowed to tender for one or or or lots (contracts). Each
 - lotorcontractwillbeevaluatedinaccordancewithITT33.2. Themethodologytodeterminethelowes tevaluatedtendererortenderersbasedonelot(contract) orbasedonacombinationoflots(contracts), willbespecifiedinSectionIII, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria. In the case of multiple lots or contracts, tenderer will be will be required to prepare the Eligibility and Qualification Criteria Form for each Lot.
- 33.5 The Procuring Entity's evaluation of a Tender will include and consider:
 - a) inthecaseofGoodsmanufacturedinKenya, salesandothersimilartaxes, which will be payable on the goods if a contract is a warded to the Tenderer;
 - b) inthecaseofGoodsmanufacturedoutsideKenya,alreadyimportedortobeimported,customsdu tiesandotherimporttaxesleviedontheimportedGood,salesandothersimilartaxes,whichwillb epayableontheGoodsifthecontractisawardedtotheTenderer;

33.6 TheProcuringEntity'sevaluationofaTendermayrequiretheconsiderationofotherfactors,inadditiontotheTenderPricequotedinaccordancewithITT14. Thesefactors may be related to the characteristics, performance, and terms and conditions of purchase of the Goods and Related Services. 1. Purpose

1.1 TheGovernmentofKenya'sAnti~

CorruptionandEconomicCrimelawsandtheirsanction'spoliciesandprocedures, PublicProcureme ntandAssetDisposalAct (no.33of2015) and itsRegulation, and anyotherKenya's ActsorRegulations related to Fraudand Corruption, and similar offences, shall apply with respect to Public Procurement Processes and Contracts that are governed by the laws of Kenya.

2. Requirements

2.1

The Government of Kenyare quires that all parties including Procuring Entities, Tenderers, (applicant s/proposers), Consultants, Contractors and Suppliers; any Sub-contractors, Sub-consultants, Service providers or Suppliers; any Agents (whether declared or not); and any of their Personnel, involved and engaged in procurement under Kenya's Laws and Regulation, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process, selection and contract execution of all contracts, and drefrain from Fraud and Corruption and fully comply with Kenya's laws and Regulations as perparagraphs 1.1 above.

2.2 Kenya's public procurementandassetdisposalact (no.33of2015) under Section 66 describes rules to be followed and actions to be taken indealing with Corrupt, Coercive, Obstructive, Collusive or Fraudulent practices, a nd Conflicts of Interest in procurement including consequences for offences committed. A few of the provisions noted below highlight Kenya's policy of notolerance for such practices and behaviour:

SECTION VI ~ GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Definitions

IntheConditionsofContract("theseConditions"), whichincludeSpecialConditions, PartsAandB, andth eseGeneralConditions, thefollowingwords and expressions shall have the meanings stated. Words indicating persons or parties include corporations and other legalentities, except where the context requires oth erwise.

- a) "Contract" means the Contract Agreement entered into between the Procuring Entity and the Supplier, together with the Contract Documents referred to therein, including all attachments, appendices, and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- b) "ContractDocuments" meansthedocuments listed in the Contract Agreement, including any amendments thereto.
- c) "ContractPrice" meansthepricepayabletothe Supplier as specified in the Contract Agreement, subject to osuch additions and adjustments theretoorded uctions therefrom, as may be made pursuant to the Contract
- d) "Day" means calendar day.
- e) "Completion" meansthefulfilmentoftheRelatedServicesbytheSupplierinaccordancewiththetermsa ndconditionssetforthintheContract.
- f) "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract.
- g) "Goods" means all of the commodities, raw material, machinery and equipment, and/or other material sthat the Supplier is required to supply to the Procuring Entity under the Contract.
- h) "ProcuringEntity" meanstheProcuringEntitypurchasingtheGoodsandRelatedServices,asspecifiedintheSCC.
- i) "RelatedServices" meanstheservices incidental to the supply of the goods, such as insurance, delivery, in stallation, commissioning, training and initial maintenance and other such obligations of the Supplieru nder the Contract.
- j) "SCC" means the Special Conditions of Contract.
- k) "Subcontractor" means any person, private or government entity, or a combination of the above, to who many part of the Goods to be supplied or execution of any part of the Related Services is subcontracted by the Supplier.
- 1) "Supplier" meanstheperson, private or government entity, or a combination of the above, whose Tender toper form the Contract has been accepted by the Procuring Entity and is named as such in the Contract Agreement
- m) "BaseDate" meansadate30 day prior to the submission of tenders.
- n) "Laws" means all national legislation, statutes, ordinances, and regulations and by laws of any legally constituted publicauthority.
- o) "LetterofAcceptance" meanstheletterofformalacceptance, signed by the contractor. Procuring Entity, including any annexed memorand a comprising agreements between and signed by both Parties.
- p) "ProcuringEntity" meanstheEntitynamedintheSpecialConditionsofContract.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 Ifthecontextsorequiresit, singular means plural and viceversa.
- 2.2 Incoterms
 - a) UnlessinconsistentwithanyprovisionoftheContract, themeaning of anytradeterm and the right tsandobligations of parties thereundershall be as prescribed by Incoterms specified in the SCC.
 - b) ThetermsEXWandCIPandothersimilarterms, when used, shall be governed by the rules prescribed in the current edition of Incoterms specified in the SCC and published by the International Chamber of Commerce in Paris, France.

3. Contract Documents

Subject to the order of precedence set for thin the Contract Agreement, all documents for ming the Contract (and all parts thereof) are intended to be correlative, complementary, and mutually explanatory. The Contract Agreement shall be read as a

whole. The documents forming the Contract shall be interpreted in the following order of priority:

4. Fraud and Corruption

5.2 The Suppliers hall be a rall costs of translation to the governing language and all risks of the accuracy of such translation, for documents provided by the Supplier.

6. Joint Venture, Consortium or Association

If the Supplier is a joint venture, consortium, or association, all of the parties shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity for the fulfilment of the provisions of the Contract and shall design at eone member of the joint venture, consortium, or association to act as a leader with authority to bind the joint venture, consortium, or associations that in other large of the procuring Entity.

7. Eligibility

24.1 Unlessotherwisespecifiedinthe SCC, the Goodssupplied under the Contract shall be fully insured—in a freely convertible currency from an eligible country—against loss or damage incident altomanufacture or acquisition, transportation, storage, and delivery, in accordance with the applicable Incoterms or in the manner specified in the SCC.

25. Transportation and Incidental Services

- 25.1 Unlessotherwisespecifiedinthe **SCC**, responsibility for arranging transportation of the Goodsshallbein accordance with the specified Incoterms.
- 25.2 The Supplier may be required to provide any or all of the following services, including additional services, if any, specified **in SCC**:
 - a) Performanceorsupervisionofon-siteassemblyand/orstart-upofthesuppliedGoods;
 - b) Furnishingoftoolsrequiredforassemblyand/ormaintenanceofthesuppliedGoods;
 - c) Furnishingofadetailedoperationsandmaintenancemanualforeachappropriateunitofthesup pliedGoods:
 - d) Performanceorsupervisionormaintenanceand/orrepairofthesuppliedGoods,foraperiodofti meagreedbytheparties,providedthatthisserviceshallnotrelievetheSupplierofanywarrantyob ligationsunderthisContract;and
 - e) TrainingoftheProcuringEntity'spersonnel,attheSupplier'splantand/oron-site,inassembly,start-up,operation,maintenance,and/orrepairofthesuppliedGoods.
- 25.3 PriceschargedbytheSupplierforincidentalservices,ifnotincludedintheContractPricefortheGoods,s hallbeagreeduponinadvancebythepartiesandshallnotexceedtheprevailingrateschargedtootherpartiesbytheSupplierforsimilarservices

26. Inspections and Tests

- 26.1 The Suppliers hall at its own expense and at no cost to the Procuring Entity carry out all such tests and/or in spections of the Goods and Related Services as a respecified in the SCC.
- 26.2 Theinspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its Subcontractor, at point of delivery, and/or at the Goods' final destination, or in another place in Kenyaas specified in the SCC. Subject to GCC Sub-
 - Clause 26.3, if conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its Subcontractor, all reasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawings and production data, shall be furnished to the inspectors at noch arge to the Procuring Entity.

- 26.5 TheProcuringEntitymayrequiretheSuppliertocarryoutanytestand/orinspectionnotrequiredbythe ContractbutdeemednecessarytoverifythatthecharacteristicsandperformanceoftheGoodscomplyw iththetechnicalspecificationscodesandstandardsundertheContract,providedthattheSupplier'sreas onablecostsandexpensesincurredinthecarryingoutofsuchtestand/orinspectionshallbeaddedtothe ContractPrice.Further,ifsuchtestand/orinspectionimpedestheprogressofmanufacturingand/orth eSupplier'sperformance ofitsotherobligationsundertheContract,dueallowancewillbemadeinrespectoftheDeliveryDatesan dCompletionDatesandtheotherobligationssoaffected.
- 26.6 The Suppliers hall provide the Procuring Entity with a report of the results of any such test and/or inspection.
- 26.7 The Procuring Entity may reject any Goods or any part thereof that fail to pass any test and/or inspection or do not conform to the specifications. The Suppliers hall either rectify or replace such rejected Goods or parts thereoformake alterations necessary to meet the specifications at no cost to the Procuring Entity, and shall repeat the test and/or inspection, at no cost to the Procuring Entity, upon giving an otice pursuant to GC CSub-Clause 26.4.
- 26.8 TheSupplieragreesthatneithertheexecutionofatestand/orinspectionoftheGoodsoranypartthereof, northeattendancebytheProcuringEntityoritsrepresentative,northeissueofanyreportpursuanttoGC CSub-Clause26.6,shallreleasetheSupplierfromanywarrantiesorotherobligationsundertheContract.

27. Liquidated Damages

27.1ExceptasprovidedunderGCCClause32,iftheSupplierfailstodeliveranyoralloftheGoodsbytheDate(s) ofdeliveryorperformtheRelatedServiceswithintheperiodspecifiedintheContract,theProcuringEnti tymaywithoutprejudicetoallitsotherremediesundertheContract,deductfromtheContractPrice,asli quidateddamages,asumequivalenttothepercentagespecifiedintheSCCofthedeliveredpriceofthedel ayedGoodsorunperformedServicesforeachweekorpartthereofofdelayuntilactualdeliveryorperfor mance,uptoamaximumdeductionofthepercentagespecifiedinthoseSCC.Oncethemaximumisreac hed,theProcuringEntitymayterminatetheContractpursuanttoGCCClause35.

28. Warranty

- 28.1 The Supplier warrants that all the Goods are new, unused, and of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements indesign and materials, unless provided otherwise in the Contract.
- 282 SubjecttoGCCSub-Clause22.1(b),theSupplierfurtherwarrantsthattheGoodsshallbefreefromdefectsarisingfromanya ctoromissionoftheSupplierorarisingfromdesign,materials,andworkmanship,undernormaluseint heconditionsprevailinginthecountryoffinaldestination.
- 283 Unlessotherwisespecifiedinthe SCC, thewarrantyshallremainvalidfortwelve (12) months after the Goods, or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to and accepted at the final destination in dicated in the SCC, or foreighteen (18) months after the date of shipment from the portor place of load in ginthe country of origin, which ever period concludes earlier.

Notwithstandingtheforegoing,suchadditionalorreducedcostshallnotbeseparatelypaidorcreditedi fthesamehasalreadybeenaccountedforinthepriceadjustmentprovisionswhereapplicable,inaccord ancewithGCCClause15.

32. Force Majeure

- 32.1 The Suppliers hall not be liable for for feiture of its Performance Security, liquidated damages, or termina tion for default if and to the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.

352 Termination for Insolvency.

The Procuring Entity may at any time terminate the Contract by giving notice to the Supplier if the Supplier becomes bank rup to rother wise in solvent. 37. Export Restriction

37.1 NotwithstandinganyobligationundertheContracttocompleteallexportformalities,anyexportrestri ctionsattributabletotheProcuringEntity,toKenya,ortotheuseoftheproducts/goods,systemsorservic estobe

supplied, which arise from traderegulations from a country supplying those products/goods, systems or services, and which substantially impede the Supplier from meeting its obligations under the Contract, shall release the Supplier from the obligation to provide deliveries or services, always provided, however, that the Supplier can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Procuring Entity that it has completed all formalities in a timely manner, including applying for permits, authorizations and licenses necessary for the export of the products/goods, systems or services under the terms of the Contract. Termination of the Contract on this basis shall be for the Procuring Entity's convenience pursuant to Sub-Clause 35.3.
